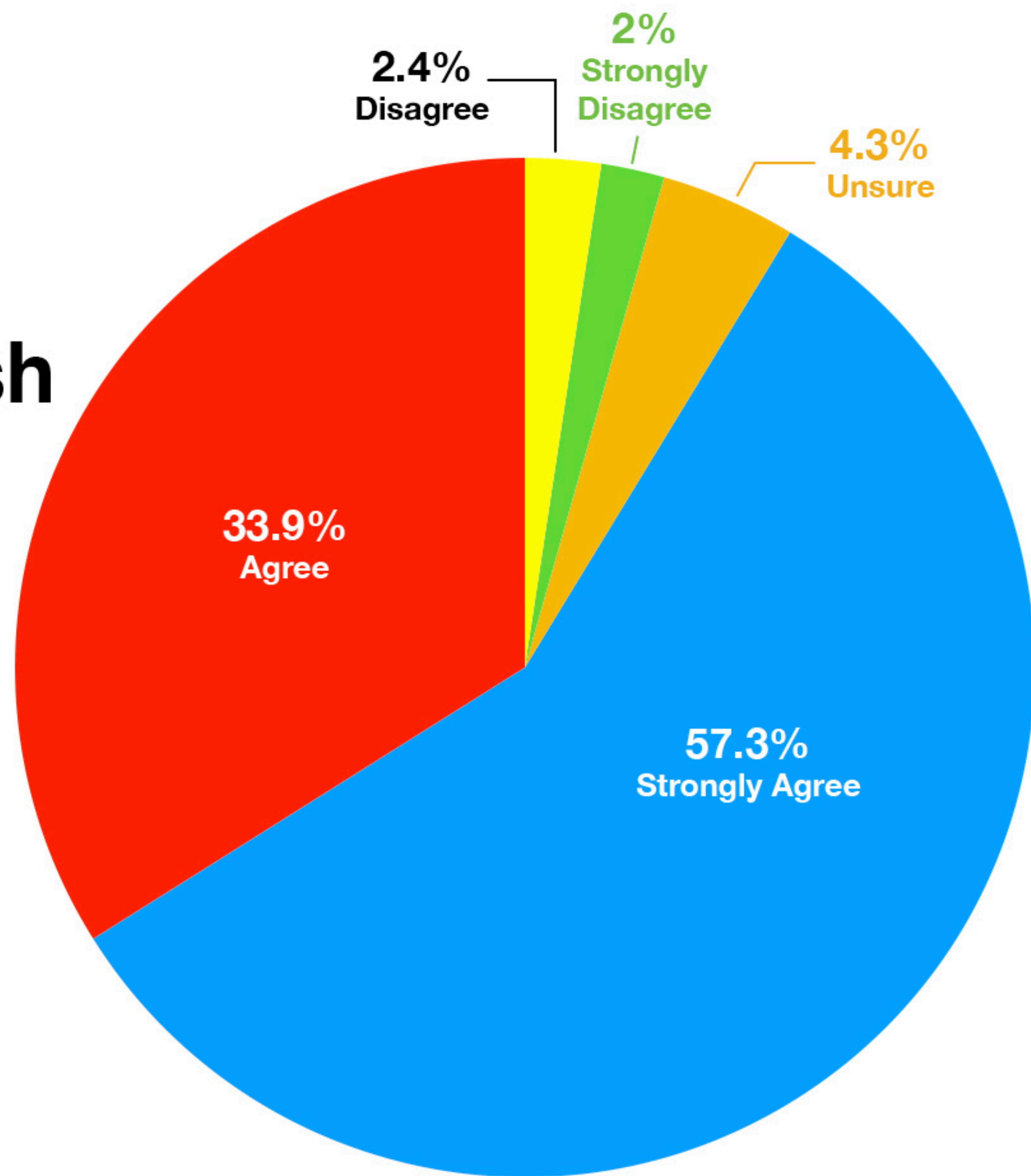


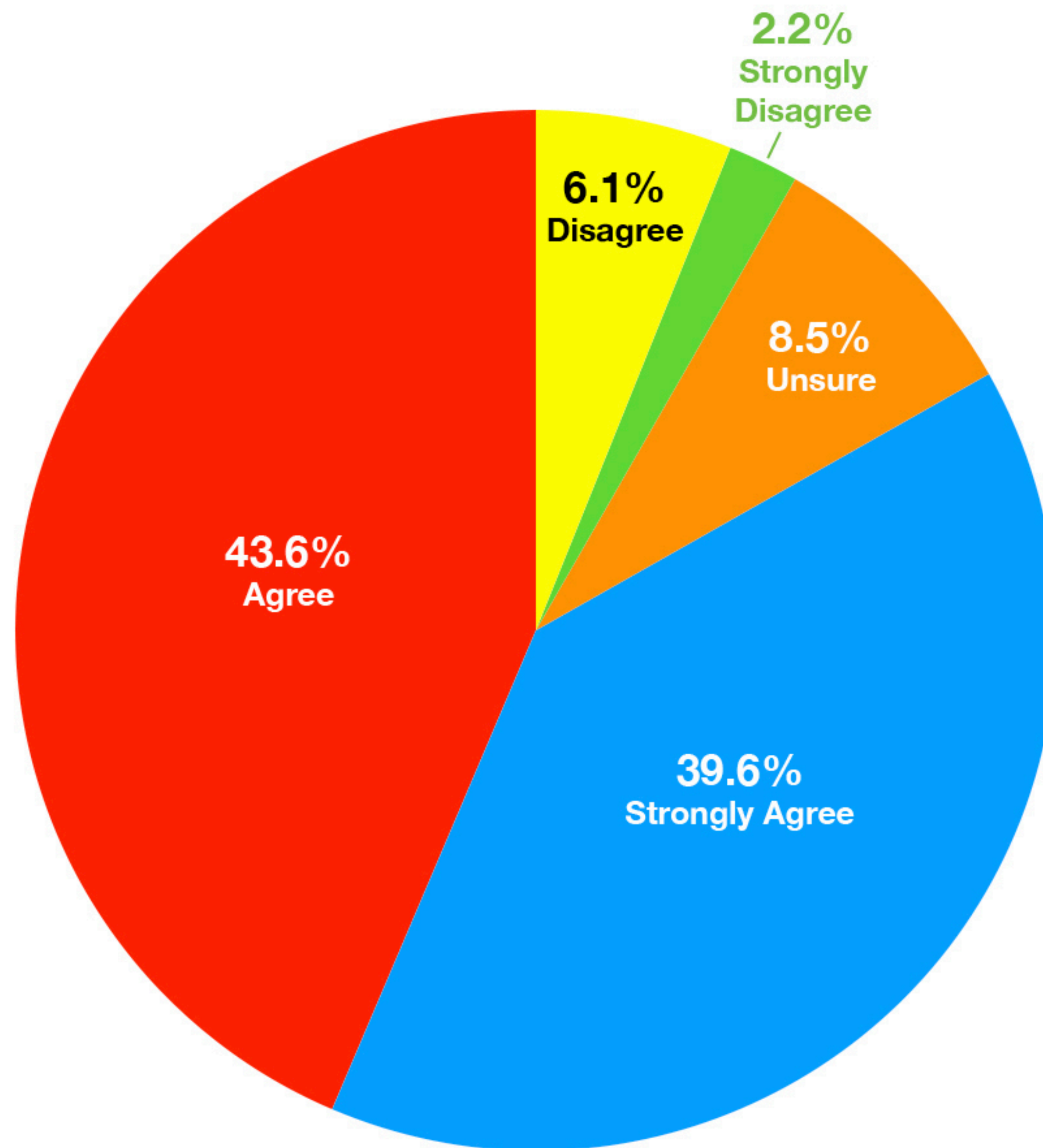

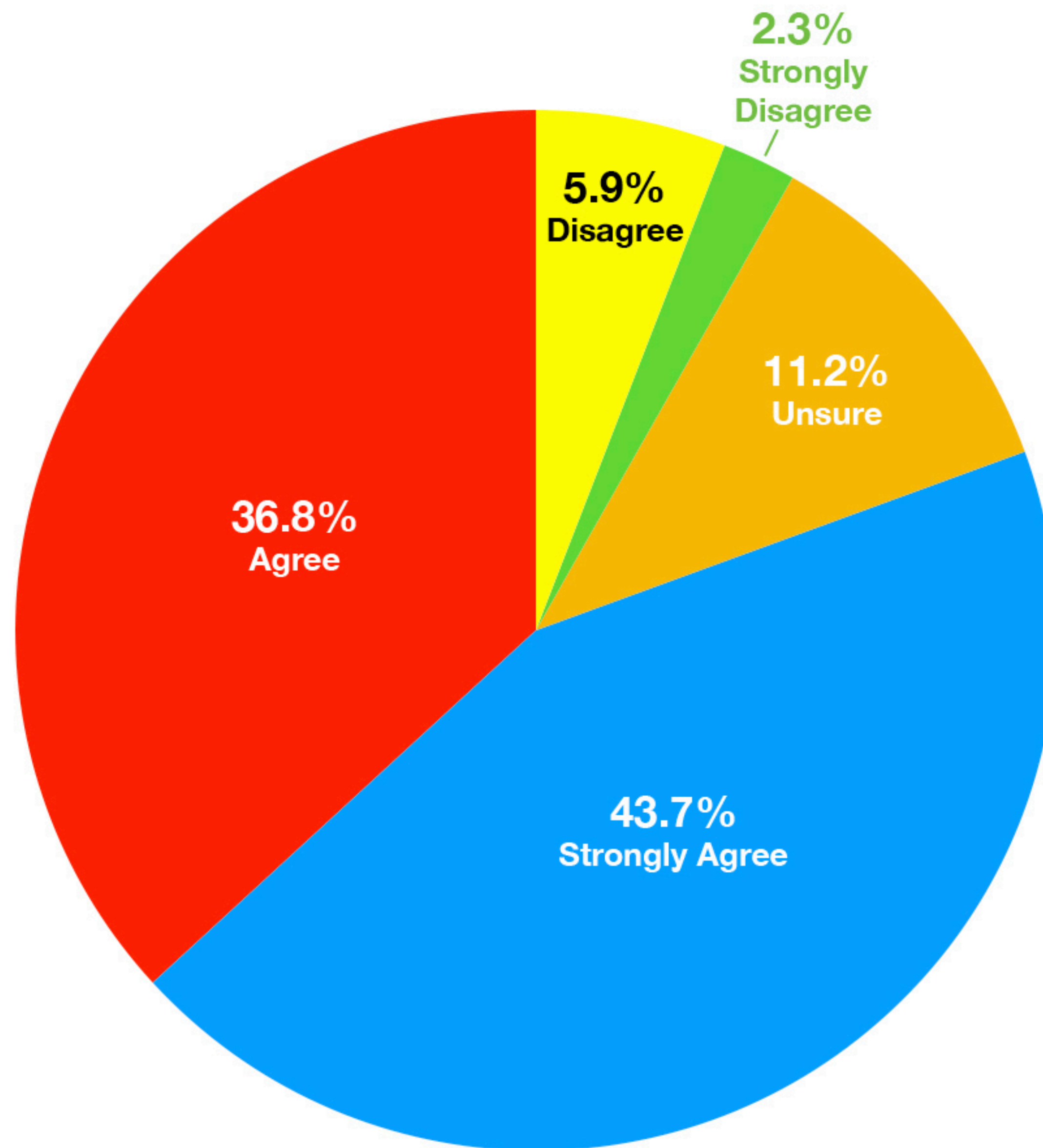
A decline in CP participation would hurt missions and ministry effectiveness.

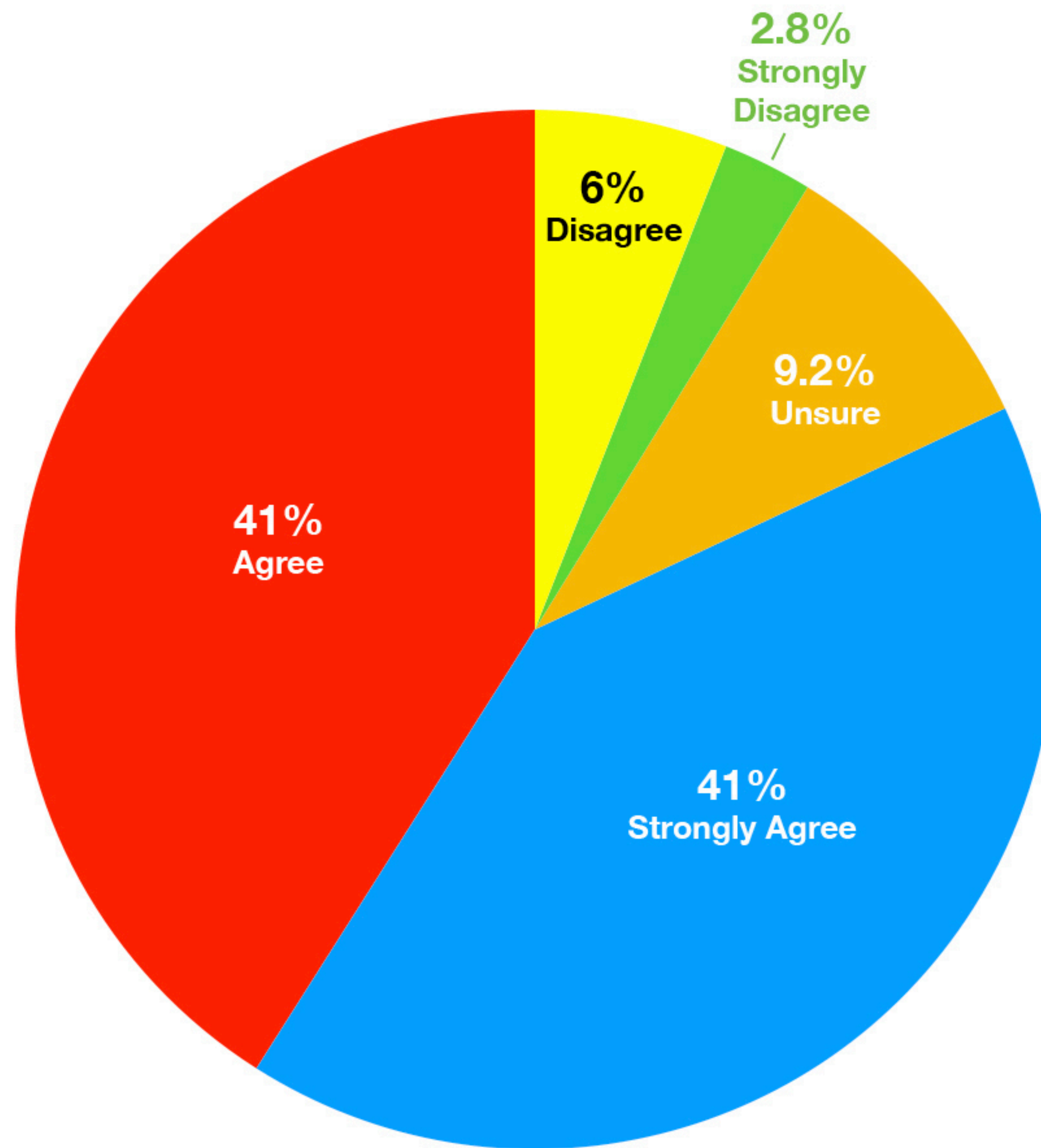

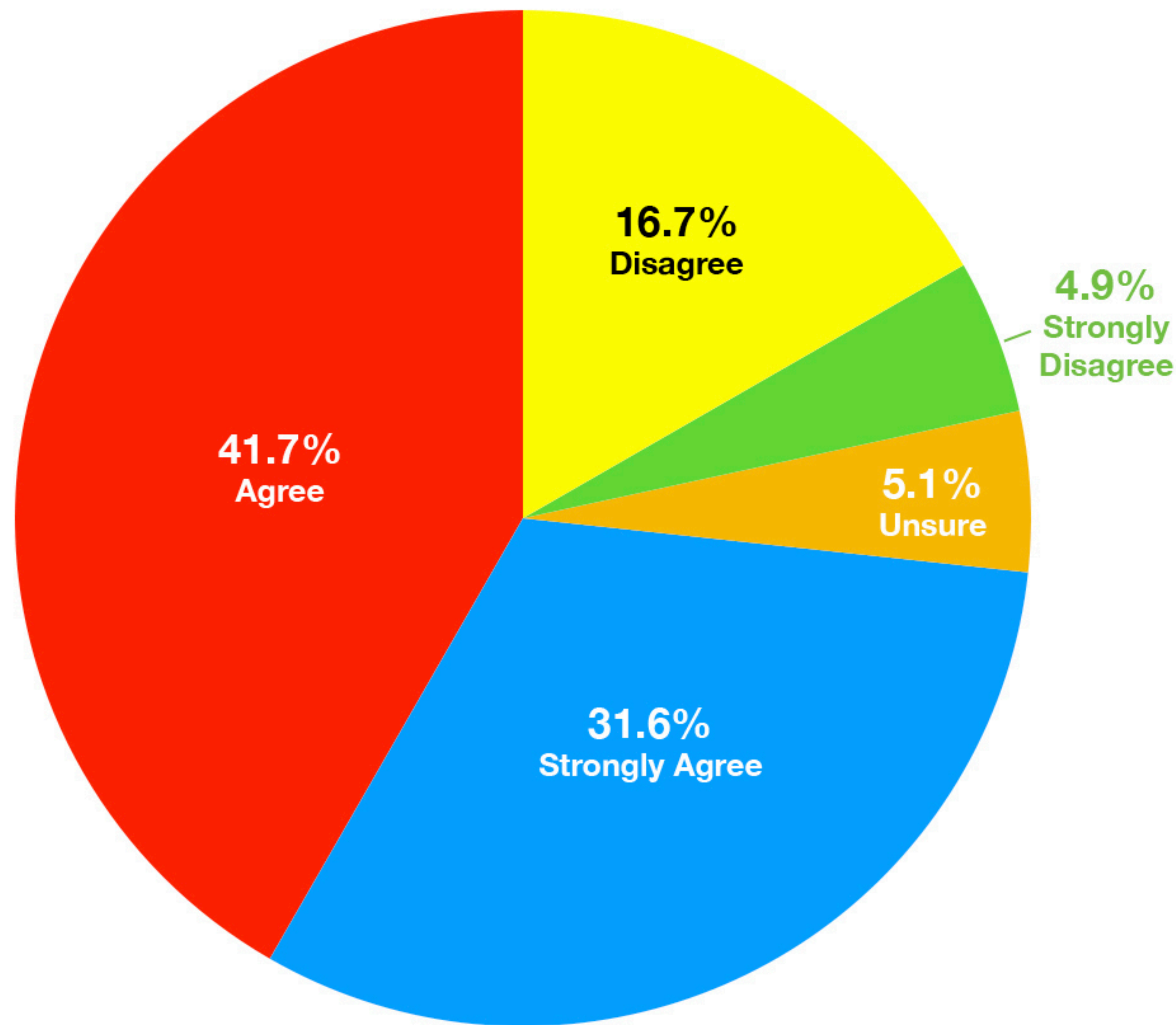

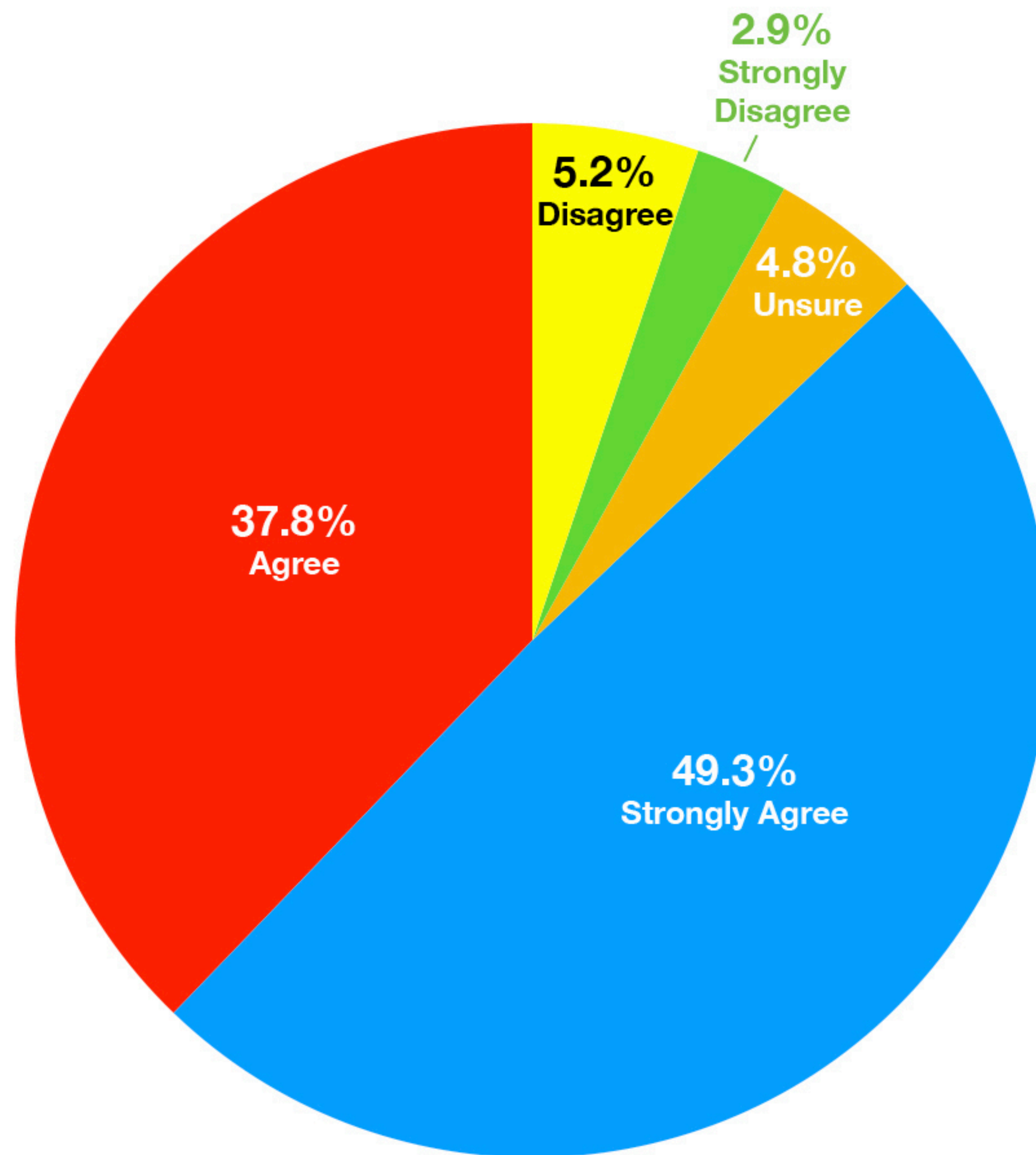

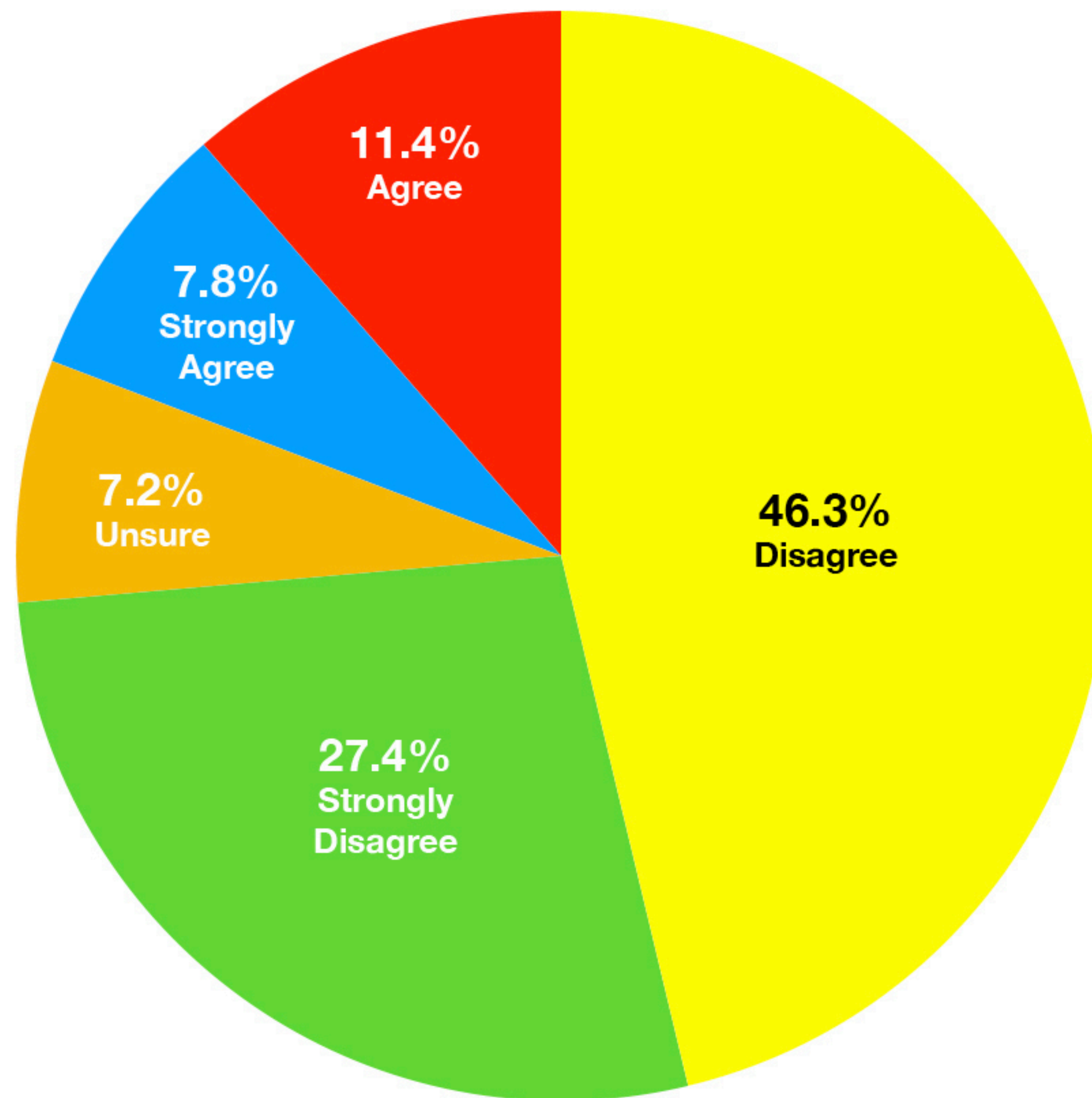

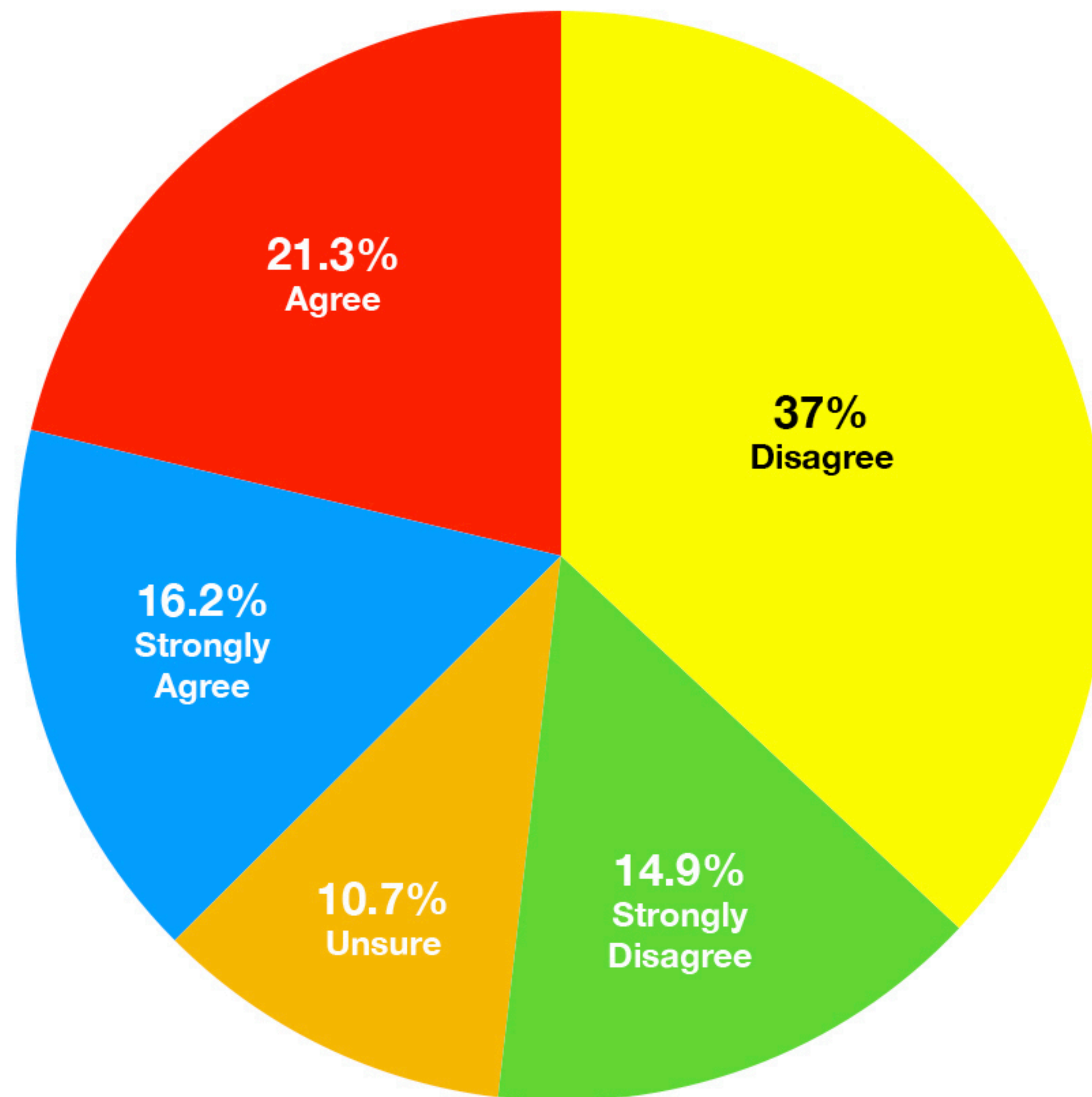

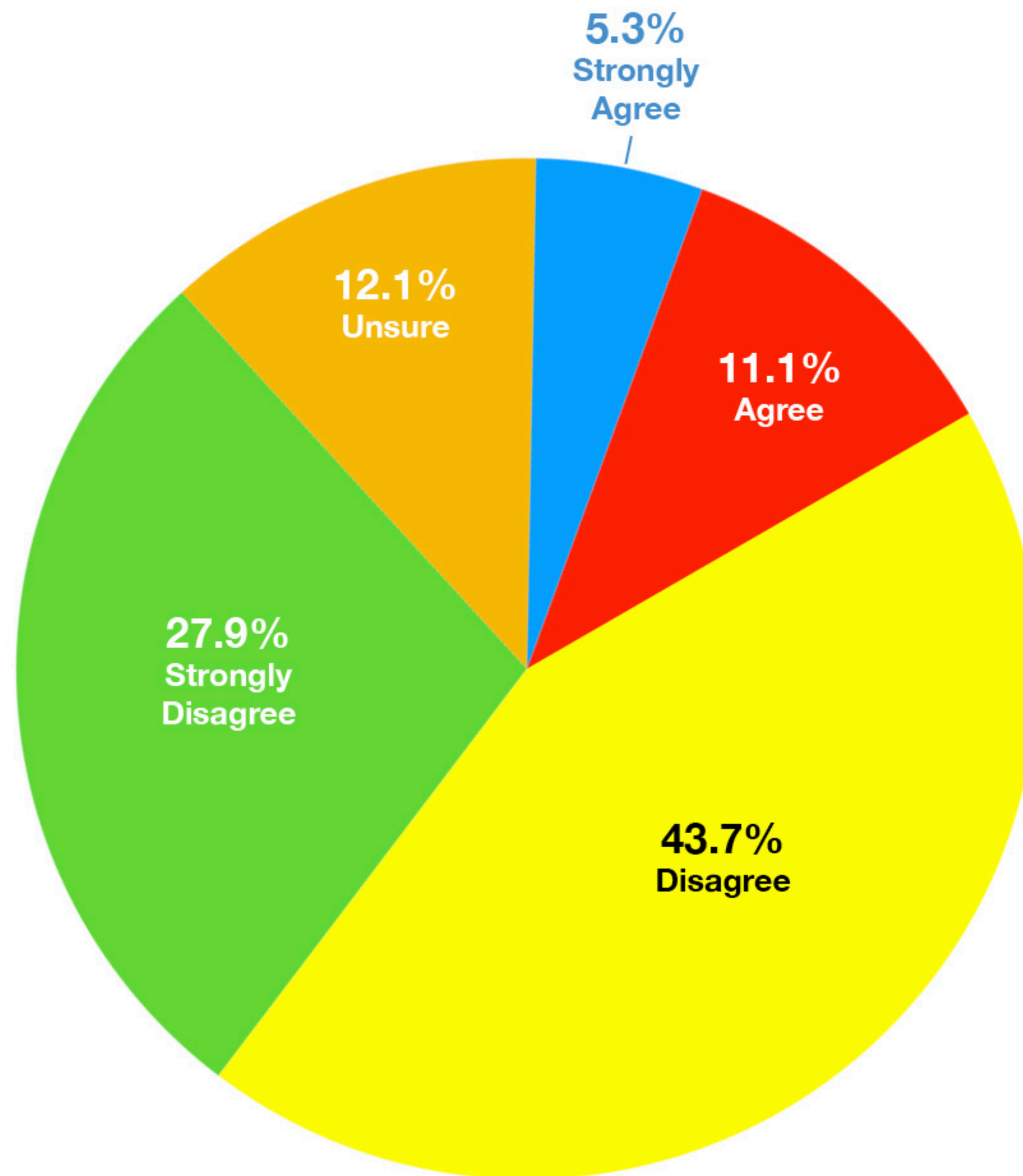

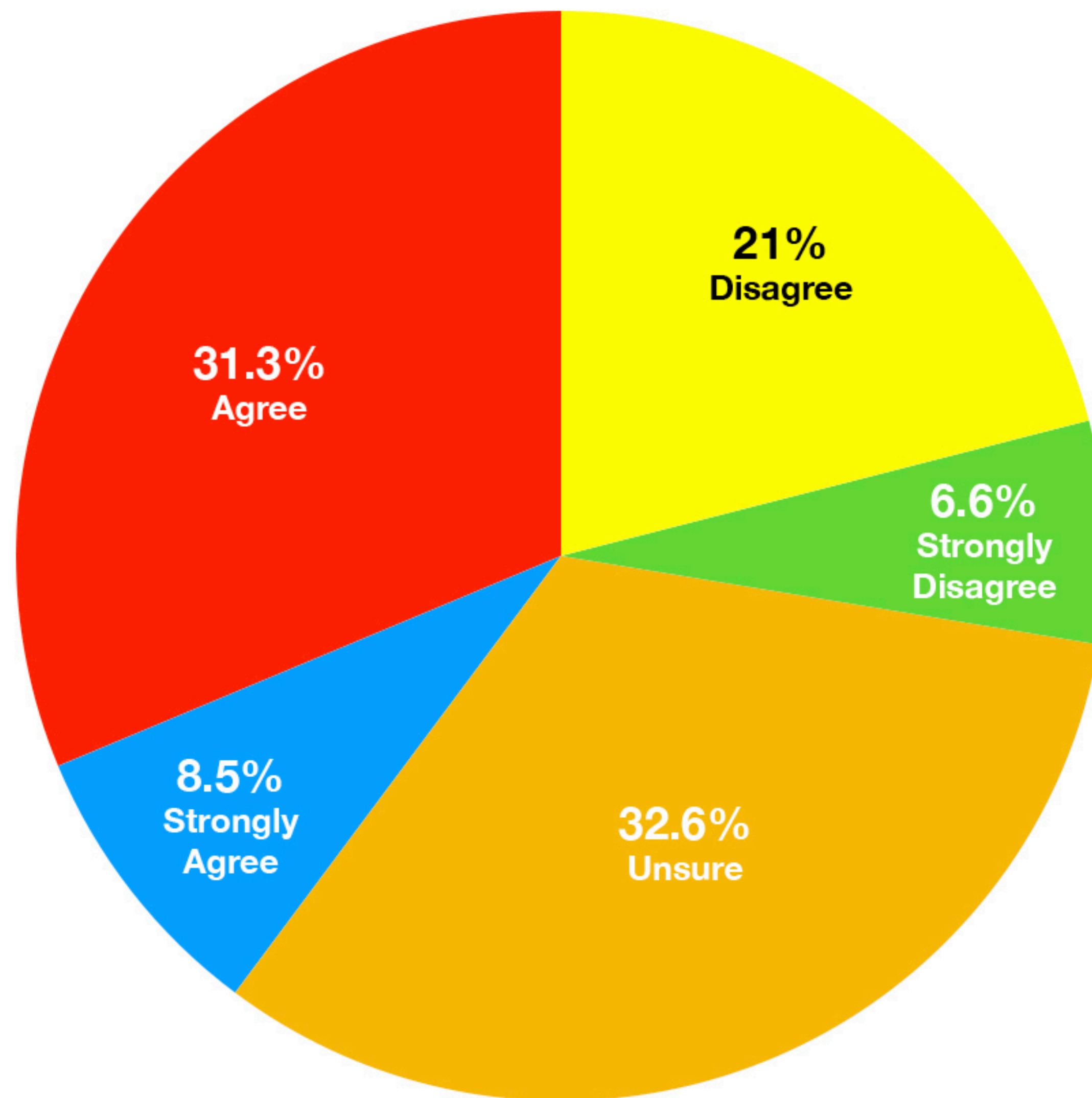

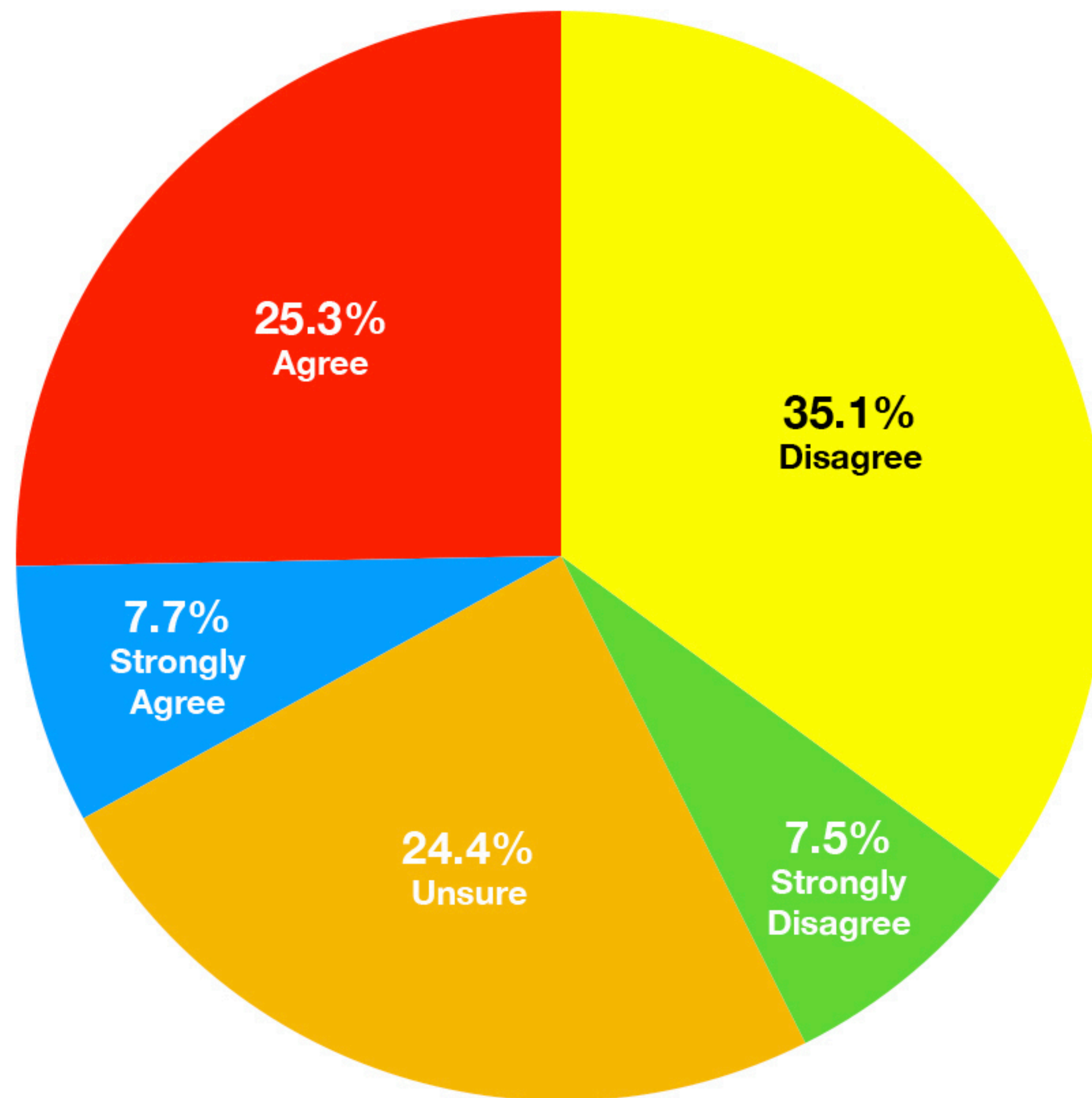

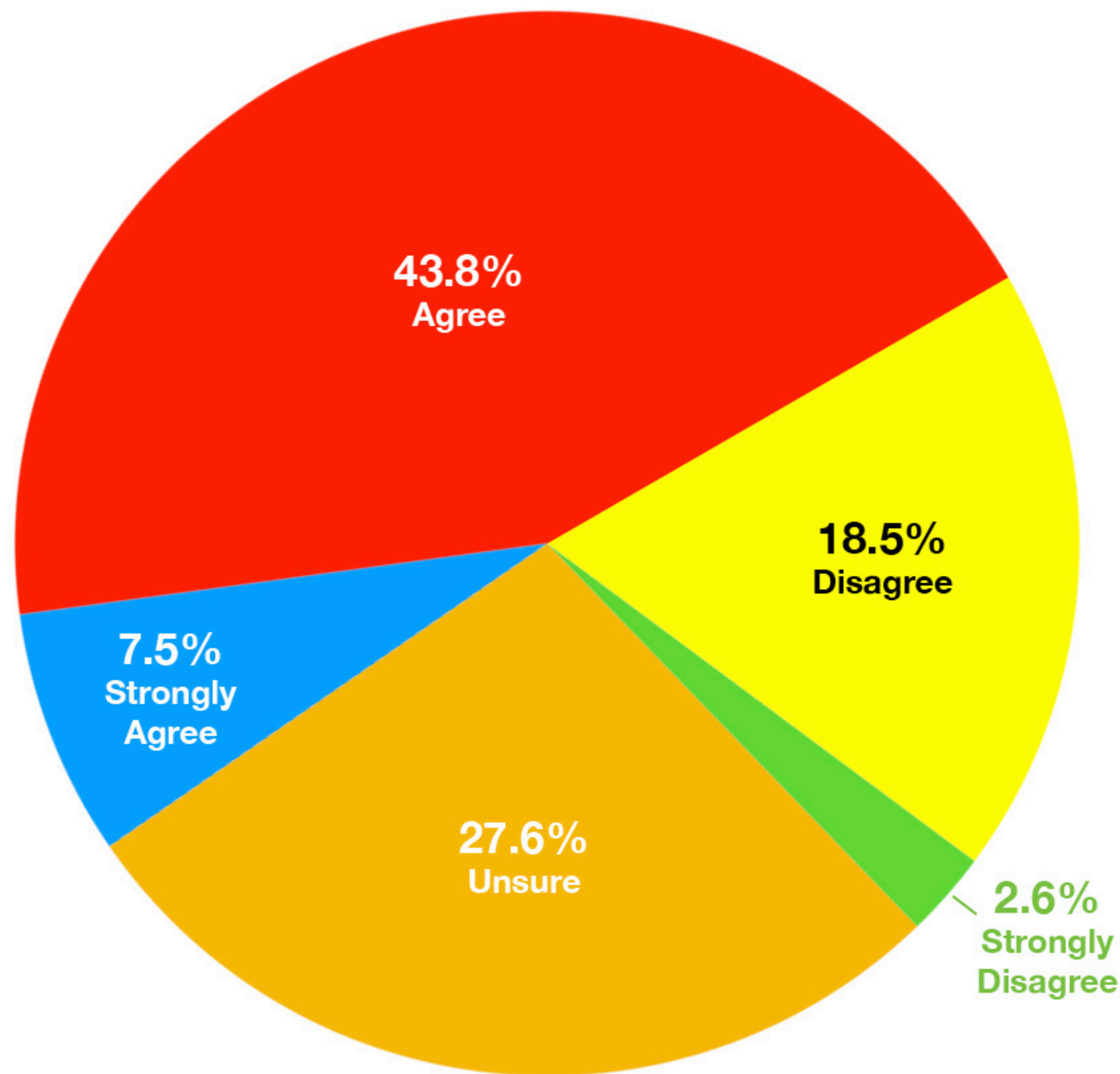
